Girls Inc. of the Central Coast Programs:

The dominant characteristic of GICC is our **Youth Leaders Program**. We are the only Girls Inc. affiliate to offer programs entirely facilitated by teens. The Youth Leader program is a paid internship in which ECHO graduates have opportunities to continue their leadership development by delivering programs to young women in all GICC Programs. These young women work in close partnership with GICC staff and volunteer program advocates. (30-40 young women/year)

- **1. ECHO Program** is a year-long leadership program that works with 15-17 year old girls. The program is designed to encourage these young women to pursue postsecondary education, and plan for future careers. (200-270 young women/year) **Cost \$26,000 per school site**
- **2. Smart Choices Summer Program** is a week-long summer program that takes place on a local college campus and inspires girls entering high school to make positive life choices about health, relationships, and school. This program includes room and board for the entire week. (70-90 girls/summer) **Cost \$56,350**
- **3. Friendly PEERsuasion®** approaches drug abuse prevention as a peer issue, using the positive influence of young people modeling healthy behaviors. This two-part program trains girls ages 11-14 to serve as role models and teachers who plan and lead substance abuse prevention activities to groups of 10-year-old girls. (400-600 girls/year) **Cost \$11,890 per school site**
- **4. Will Power/Won't Power®** is a series of interactive assertive communication workshops for girls ages 12-14 that focus on values and healthy relationships; it helps girls identify and avoid risky situations, provides factual information on female health and the reproductive system, and encourages girls to value and support each other in making healthy decisions. (250-270 girls/year) **Cost \$6,250 per school site**
- **5. Growing Together®** is designed to increase positive communication between mothers (or other significant adults) and their 9-to 12-year-old daughters and to help them discuss questions about sexual behavior and puberty without embarrassment.(200-300 girls and their mothers/year) **Cost \$4,150 per school site**
